QUALIFICATIONS, EXPERIENCE AND AGE LIMITS FOR INITIAL APPOINTMENT

4. A candidate must possess the educational qualifications and experience and must be within the age limits as mentioned against the post concerned in the Schedule to this Notification:

Provided that the maximum age limits will be relaxed by 3 years in the case of candidates belonging to Schedule Castes, Budhist Community recognized trribes of the Tribal Areas, Azad Kashmir and Northern Areas, (District of Gilgit, Skardu and Diamir), in accordance with the instructions issued by the Establishment Division:

Provided further that for Government servants who have completed at least 2 years continuous Government service, maximum age limit may be relayable not more than 10 years upto the age of 55 years.

QUALIFICATIONS CONDITIONS FOR TRANSFER

5. Appointments by transfer shall be made from amongst the persons holding appointment under the Federal Government on a regular basis in the same Basic Pay Scale in which the post to be filled exists, provided the person concerned possess the qualifications experience prescribed for initial appointment or promotion to the post concerned.

PROBATION '

- 6. Persons appointed by promotion or initial appointment or transfer shall be on probation for a period of one year. This period may be curtailed for good and sufficient reasons to be recorded, or, if considered necessary it may be extended for a period not exceeding one year as may be prescribed at the time of appointment. Appointment on probation shall be subject to the provisions of section 6 of the Civil Servants Act, 1973.
