Qualification/Conditions for Transfer.—The posts reserved for transfer shall be filled in from amongst the persons holding appointment on a regular basis in Pakistan Railways other than those working in Accounts, Medical and Police Departments, in the same pay scale in which the post to be filled up exists provided the persons concerned possess the qualifications and experience prescribed for promotion to the post concerned. Only those persons will be transferred to the posts in the Personnel Branch who are facing promotion blockage in their own department.

This period may be curtailed for good and sufficient reasons to be recorded or if considered necessary, it may be extended for a period not exceeding one year as may be prescribed at the time of appointment. Appointment on probation shall be subject to the provisions of Section 6 of Civil Servants Act, 1973.
