- Notes.— (i) The posts for which the method of appointment has been indicated as "By promotion/transfer" will be filled up by promotion, only if suitable persons are available, otherwise by transfer.
- (ii) The posts of Secretary, Railway Board (BPS-20), Director Planning (BPS-20), Joint Director Planning (BPS-19) and Deputy Director Planning (BPS-18) will be filled up by officers other than those of the Stores/Purchase, Accounts, Medical and Police Departments of Pakistan Railways.
- (iii) The posts of Director Procurement (BPS-20) and Joint Director Procurement (BPS-19) will be filled up by officers other than those of Transportation (Traffic) and Commercial, Accounts, Medical and Police Departments of the Pakistan Railways.
- (iv) The posts of Joint Directors/Admn. and Establishment, when filled up by transfer will be from officers other than those of the Accounts, Medical and Police Departments of the Pakistan Railways.

- (v) Other posts in BPS 20, 19, 18 and 17 when filled up by transfer will be from the officers of the respective departments.
- (vi) BPS 19 and 18 posts in Planning Wing will be designated as Joint Director Planning and Deputy Director Planning respectively when filled up by transfer, otherwise as Deputy Chief Planning/Assistant Chief Planning.
- (vii) (a) Like Section Officers in other Ministries/Divisions: 50% of the total posts of Assistant Directors will be in BPS 18 and the remaining 50% in BPS 17. In case, any upgradation is involved approval of the Finance Division will be obtained.
- (b) 40% of the posts of Assistant Directors shall be filled up in BPS 17/18 by promotion and remaining 60% by transfer of officers in BPS-17/18 on regular basis from different departments of the Pakistan Railways other than Police and Medical Departments according to job requirements.
- (c) In case suitable officers are not available for posting as Assistant Directors, the Establishment Division will be asked to nominate and post Section Officers against the posts falling to 60% quota reserved for transferees.

CONDITIONS FOR PROMOTIONS

3. Promotion to the posts in column (i) below shall be made by selection from amongst the persons who held the posts specified in column (ii) on regular basis and possess the experience/qualifications prescribed in column (iii) against each :—

QUALIFICATIONS, EXPERIENCE AND AGE LIMITS FOR INITIAL APPOINTMENT

4. A candidate must possess the educational qualifications and experience and must be within the age limits as mentioned against the post concerned in the Schedule of this Notification :

Provided that the maximum age limit will be relaxed by 3 years in the case of candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes, Buddhist community, recognised tribes of the Tribal Areas, Azad Kashmir and Northern Areas (Distts. of Gilgit, Skardu and Diamir) in accordance with the instructions issued by the Establishment Division :

Provided further that for Government servants, who have completed atleast 2 years continuous Government service, maximum age limit may be relaxed by not more than 10 years upto the age of 55 years wherever applicable.

QUALIFICATIONS/CONDITIONS FOR TRANSFER

5. Appointment by transfer shall be made from amongst the persons holding appointment on regular basis under the Federal Government in the same pay scale in which the post to be filled exists provided the persons concerned possesses the qualifications and experience prescribed for initial appointment or promotion to the post concerned.

PROBATION

6. Persons appointed by promotion or initial appointment or transfer shall be on probation for a period of one year. This period may be curtailed for good and sufficient reasons to be recorded or if considered necessary it may be extended for a period not exceeding one year as may be prescribed at the time of appointment. Appointment on probation shall be subject to the provisions of Article 6 of Civil Servants Act, 1973.

7. This Notification issues with the concurrence of the Establishment Division vide their O. M. No. 17/1/86-R. 3; dated 29-6-1988 and F.P.S.C. vide their letter No. F. 12-5/88-S, dated 20-6-1989. This supersedes the rules for recruitment to Class-I posts in the former Railway Wing of the Ministry of Communications notified vide S. R. O. 398 (K)/71 dated 25th March, 1971, and the rules for recruitment to Research Posts in the former Ministry of Railways as contained in Notification No. Admn-77/AP-2 dated 6th July, 1977.
